Financial Report

With our transition to CUHC and affiliation with Curtin Stadium the club engaged in a range of additional activities, from player recruitment to uniform changes and purchase. Key fiscal details for the 2017 year are as follows:

Income 2017

- Fees Income - approximately the same as budgeted and the previous year. No increase to fees was made so is as expected
- Sponsorship – big increase on previous year due to the sign up of 2 major sponsors for the premier league teams.
- Fundraising – a big increase on Fundraising primarily due to the successful raffle that was held.



- Uniforms – big increase in uniform income however this is negated by the big cost due to the new uniform being brought in.

Expenses 2017

- Large uniform cost due to new uniforms being brought in across all grades
- Affiliation fees up 3% from previous year as expected.
- Coaching as budgeted at the beginning of the year.
- Player imports – slightly higher due to cost overruns with rent and player payments. Extra fundraising was done to offset.
- Game Hire – as expected, slight increases across all turfs meant slightly higher than previous year.

Balance Sheet

- Assets remain similar to previous year – no increase in bank balance
- No new major assets
- Small amount of uniform inventory kept in preparation for next year.

As a summary, the financial standing of the club remains sound. There are no major concerns to the financial position of the club, the standing is as expected.

Curtin Liaison Report

Our first year of reaffiliation with Curtin University has seen the club warmly welcomed into the Curtin sporting community. The club has successfully rebranded across all our online platforms and playing uniforms, with our new Pirates logo and orange and white bringing new and old members alike to the club.

The club's integration is ongoing and I thank all our metros and veterans grass players for their enthusiasm in relocating to Curtin's South Oval as our home ground for the season. Given the heavy use of this oval by the AFL club, and the spongy nature of that turf we are negotiating with Curtin Stadium to use the Edinburgh South oval as our new ground for 2018. Curtin Stadium have indicated they are keen to support the club's move to Edinburgh South and to convert the oval into a longer term sporting ground. The turf quality of this oval is much more suitable for hockey, and its location in the heart of campus makes it a great spot to position hockey within the heart of Curtin's sporting teams.

With the move to Edinburgh South opens the possibility for the club to share access to the Edinburgh clubrooms. These rooms are currently shared by the Curtin rugby, football (soccer), gridiron and ultimate clubs. Initial feedback from the clubs has been positive and we will work to establish partnerships to provide us with another clubroom option for our grass teams and social activities.

Lease renewal negotiations between Hockey WA and Curtin University have commenced, with the term of the current lease due to expire in 2019. Current arrangements are likely to continue to apply through the 2018 season and we continue to engage in discussions with both Curtin Stadium and Curtin University in relation to field and facility access provisions.

We are also engaging with Curtin's school and visitor programs, looking to provide coaches for Curtin's holiday programs, university hockey activities and international visitors.

We look forward to our ongoing collaboration with the University and thank all club members for embracing the transition in 2017.

Membership and Recruitment Director's Report

The first year of Curtin re-affiliation lead to a significant increase in on-campus promotion of CUHC and the contribution of CUHC to the university representative student events (Western University Games and Australian University Games). The club engaged with the University through the Curtin Stadium social media accounts, and promotion of activities to students at on-campus accommodation.

CUHC was active on campus during O-week, particularly on Guild O-day with a stall set up and on-the-spot registration available for Curtin students. We provided a 50% discount on social membership for all Curtin students who registered on the day, also kept a list of details to contact the interested students regarding up-coming pre-season and grading opportunities.



Western Unigames was held in July 2017 in Bunbury, WA. This is a multi-sport intervarsity competition between the Perth based universities. The Curtin hockey teams (men and women) were supported by CUHC by providing coaches for weekly training sessions (Ian Pestana) and the 3 day tournament (Owen Clarke).

The Australian Unigames tournament is held in the Gold Coast, QLD in September 2017. CUHC provided 2 premier league selectors (Annie Gibbs and Kaitlin Nobbs) to aid the team captains in their team selection. Ian Pestana also continued to aid the Curtin Unigames teams on behalf of CUHC for the weekly training sessions preceding the games. The Curtin teams were very successful, with the following results:

Western Unigames:

- Women: 1st
- Men: 1st & 2nd (sent two teams)

Australian Unigames:

- Women: 3rd in Division 1
- Men: 6th in Division 1

Awards: CUHC athlete Lucy Irvine awarded a Green & Gold medal at the Australian Unigames for outstanding sportsmanship & skill throughout the tournament. Annie Gibbs was awarded Half Blues, and Kaitlin Nobbs Full Blues at the Curtin Sports Awards for their state and national sporting achievements.

Teams Director's Report
